

Welcome to the Drover's Camp Festival 2024

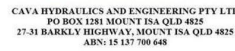
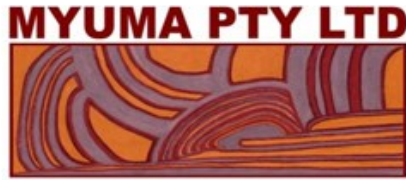
